For Travel

As a Bulgarian citizen, you will have the right to visa-free entry to 170 countries worldwide. In addition to the Schengen Area states, the United Kingdom, Canada, Japan, Singapore, and other popular jurisdictions will be open to you.



For Education

Holding a Bulgarian passport enables you to send your children to study at any university in the EU and grants them advantages over citizens of third countries. They are also entitled to apply for scholarships, benefits, tuition exemptions, and participation in student exchange programmes.



For Living in the European Union

With a Bulgarian passport, you may choose any European country for permanent residence and self-realization. You will also obtain the right to pursue a career, develop professionally, and access medical services and social protection on an equal basis with the local population.



For Employment

Citizens of Bulgaria are entitled to take up employment throughout the European Union without obtaining any additional permits. You will have access to well-paid positions for which you may apply with priority over specialists from third countries.



For Business

As a citizen of an EU member state, you have the unrestricted right to register companies, make investments, and use modern banking instruments. You also have the ability to choose any European country for tax purposes in order to optimise the tax burden on your business.

According to statistical data for 2024, holders of Bulgarian passports are refused a United States visa in approximately 6% of cases, whereas for citizens of the CIS the refusal rate is around 38–40% of all applications.

1. You provide the required documents:

- Application form in the Bulgarian language
- Birth certificate
- Birth certificates of Bulgarian ancestors
- Marriage/death certificates of ancestors
- Passport or other identity document
- Certificate of no criminal record from the country of citizenship and/or country of residence
- Medical certificate/health status document
- Passport-sized photographs
- Receipt confirming payment of the state fee

2. Who Qualifies for the Simplified Procedure

For those wishing to obtain a lawful status in the EU quickly without mandatory relocation

Bulgarian citizenship by repatriation is granted without the requirement to reside in the country or to know the language. This is an excellent opportunity to obtain an EU passport without changing your habitual way of life.

For parents concerned about their children's future

Children obtain citizenship together with their parents, which grants them access to education, healthcare, and social support in any EU country.

For those who want to travel freely

Bulgarian citizens may visit 170 countries without a visa, including the Schengen Area states, Latin American jurisdictions, Japan, and Singapore.

For investors and entrepreneurs planning to conduct business in the EU

Holding a Bulgarian passport significantly simplifies company formation and access to European banking services, and also grants the right to reside in other EU countries without additional permits.

For purchasers of real estate in Europe

Bulgarian citizens may acquire real estate in EU member states and may obtain mortgages at reduced rates and under simplified conditions.

For those planning trips to the USA, Canada, and the United Kingdom

Holders of EU passports undergo visa procedures more quickly, with fewer formalities and with a higher likelihood of approval.

For individuals seeking stability in the event of political or economic crises in their home country

Bulgarian citizenship guarantees the possibility of relocating promptly if necessary, as well as access to legal protection and support at the EU level.

3. Key Requirements for Applicants

To obtain Bulgarian citizenship by repatriation, it is necessary to prove Bulgarian origin.

This means establishing the presence of ancestors of Bulgarian nationality in your family lineage. Such proof is provided by official records – historical entries in register books, archival certificates, and church documents.

In practice, most applicants do not possess such materials, and in many cases are unaware of their right to repatriation. This is precisely where we assume the essential part of the work – our lawyers initiate official requests to state archives in Bulgaria and the CIS countries, restore missing certificates, and compile the evidentiary basis that enables you to proceed with citizenship acquisition.

Stories of Our Clients



Obtaining Bulgarian Citizenship by a Lawyer from Kazan

Yaroslav, 34 years old, a lawyer from Kazan, approached us with a clear request — he wished to have the ability to change his place of residence and employment within the European Union at any moment. Various naturalisation options were considered; however, none of them were suitable, as all programmes required many years of residence in another country.

Our lawyers conducted a detailed examination of the client's family lineage. During the analysis, Bulgarian roots were identified on his mother's side. This made it possible to apply the repatriation procedure — the simplified process for obtaining Bulgarian citizenship for persons of Bulgarian origin.

After 16 months, Yaroslav obtained Bulgarian citizenship. Today, he holds the lawful right to reside, work, and conduct business freely in any country of the European Union. This case is a demonstrative example of how legal expertise and competent guidance make it possible to find an optimal solution even when standard citizenship programmes are not applicable.



Obtaining a Bulgarian Passport by a Dentist from Gomel

Aleksei, 36 years old, a dentist from Gomel, received an inheritance and decided to invest it in relocating to the European Union, thereby securing a stable future for himself. Programmes for citizenship by investment in Europe had been closed. Standard naturalisation was also unsuitable due to lengthy residence requirements and numerous conditions imposed on applicants.

During a consultation with the lawyers of Company Jurpass, it was established that the client had Bulgarian ancestors. We confirmed the eligibility for citizenship by descent and proposed that he undergo the repatriation procedure — the simplified process for obtaining a Bulgarian passport.

After 18 months, Aleksei obtained a Bulgarian passport. He was able to relocate freely to France, where he purchased a small vineyard and established a new life as a citizen of the European Union. Aleksei's case demonstrates that even in the absence of direct investment programmes in the EU, a well-developed legal strategy allows the use of family origins for the swift and lawful acquisition of citizenship.



Obtaining Bulgarian Citizenship by an Engineer from Tula

Valeria, 32 years old, a process engineer from Tula, decided to relocate to Germany because the German labour market had an increased demand for specialists in her field. Valeria had employment offers in Cologne and Mannheim – German companies highly appreciated her qualifications during joint project work. However, the standard route of naturalisation in Germany was unsuitable: long-term residence under a residence permit did not provide the necessary stability and guarantees for her husband and daughter.

The lawyers of Company Jurpass analysed her family lineage. During the process, they were able to establish Bulgarian origin, which had not been discussed in the family due to Stalin-era repressions. This made it possible to apply for the repatriation procedure and obtain Bulgarian citizenship through the simplified route.

After 20 months, Valeria obtained her Bulgarian passport; her daughter received the status automatically. Together with her daughter, she moved to Mannheim, where she began working under a German employment contract as a citizen of the European Union. A residence permit was issued to her husband as a family member of an EU citizen.



Obtaining a Bulgarian Passport by an Entrepreneur from Gyumri (Armenia)

Ashot, 45 years old, a Doctor of Chemical Sciences from the Armenian city of Gyumri, decided to relocate to the European Union to gain greater opportunities for professional development. His publications in international journals, academic degree, and connections among colleagues worldwide gave him promising prospects for rapid career growth.

Ashot consulted us to determine an immigration strategy. He wished to apply his potential in Europe; however, standard routes – long-term visas or naturalisation – required prolonged waiting and did not provide sufficient stability for his family. During the consultation, it became clear that Ashot's mother was an ethnic Bulgarian. This allowed him to use the repatriation procedure and obtain Bulgarian citizenship through the simplified process.

Ashot received his Bulgarian passport after 17 months. He and his family relocated to Oslo, where he continued his scientific career at a modern research centre. His daughter is preparing to enter university, and his wife is adapting and learning the language. This case demonstrates that for highly qualified specialists, the simplified citizenship procedure is a practical instrument for professional and personal advancement.



Obtaining Bulgarian Citizenship by an Entrepreneur from Saint Petersburg

Boris, 37 years old, an entrepreneur from Saint Petersburg, began considering relocation to Europe. He managed a seafood restaurant in Saint Petersburg and saw excellent prospects for scaling his business specifically in Spain, where culinary traditions ideally matched his area of expertise. Additionally, political instability in his home country raised concerns about the safety of his family, and his daughter required a mild maritime climate for health reasons.

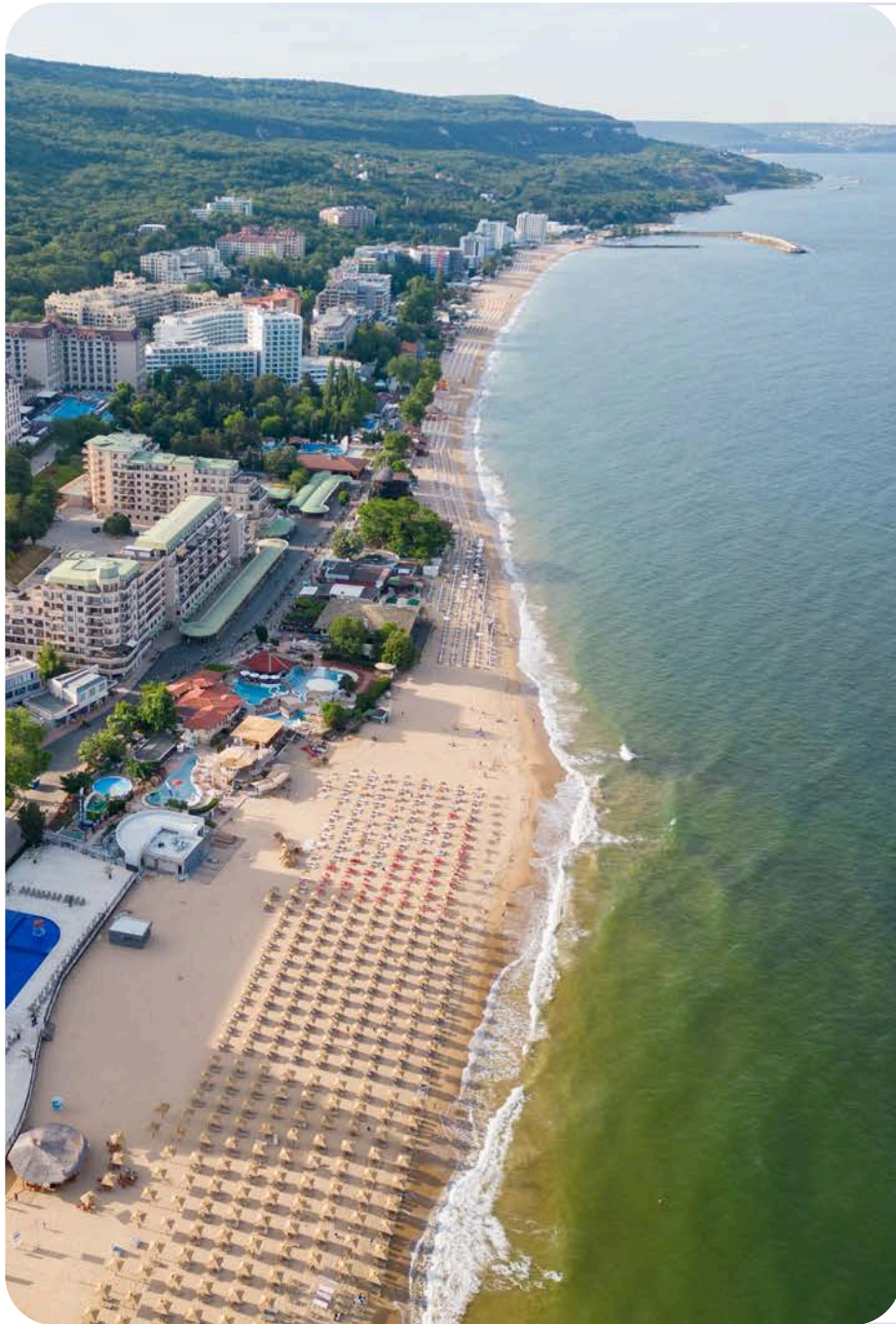
