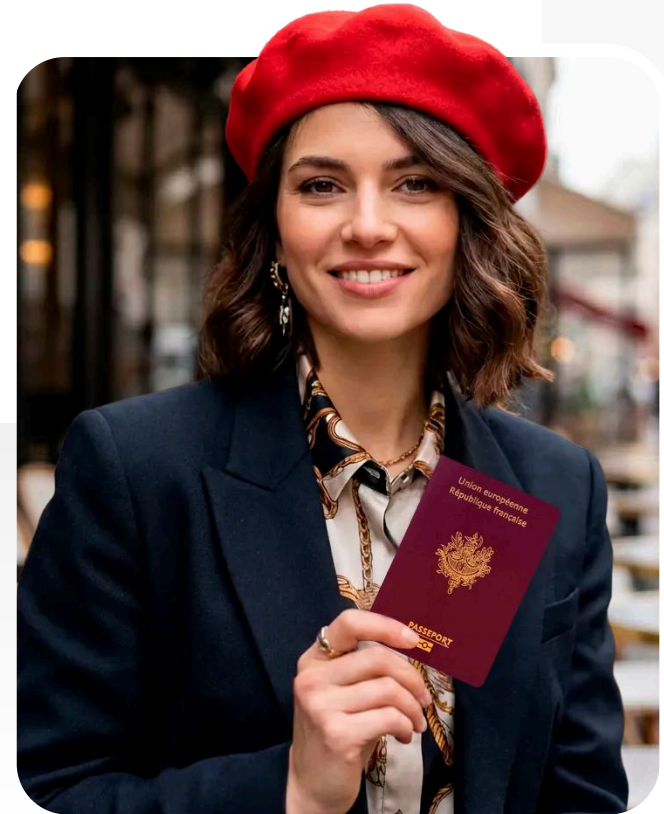

Visa-Free Destinations with a French Passport

A French passport opens the borders of 174 countries without the need to obtain a visa in advance. Travel throughout the European Union and the Schengen Area becomes exceptionally convenient due to the absence of border controls. The passport of one of the world's most developed countries will enhance your mobility and provide genuine freedom of movement.

Visa-Free Regime (Visa Free)

Visa-free entry means that you may travel to a country without obtaining a visa in advance and remain there for a limited period. Upon arrival, a standard border-entry stamp is usually placed in the passport.

Visa on Arrival

Visa on Arrival is an entry permit issued directly at the point of arrival (airport or seaport).

Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA)

ETA ([Electronic Travel Authorization](#)) is an electronic authorization for visa-free entry obtained online before travel. It is linked to your passport and required for visiting certain countries with simplified entry procedures.

Obtaining U.S. and Canadian Visas



For long-term residence or purposes not covered by ESTA/ETA, French citizens must obtain visas through U.S. and Canadian consulates.

The key advantage is the exceptionally high level of trust demonstrated by consular authorities. According to official data from the U.S. Department of State for fiscal year 2024, the refusal rate for B-category visas (tourist and business visas) for French citizens was only 8.5%.

By comparison, refusal rates amounted to 38.56% for Russian citizens, 46.29% for citizens of Kazakhstan, 72.54% for citizens of Uzbekistan, 39.14% for citizens of Kyrgyzstan, and 45.24% for citizens of Tajikistan.

Romanian and Bulgarian repatriation citizenship programs represent the most accessible and fastest options for immigration to the European Union. Unlike France, where naturalization requires years of residence and passing a language examination, Romanian and Bulgarian procedures require only confirmation of ancestry or territorial affiliation.

You are not required to relocate or renounce your current citizenship. The entire process takes approximately 12 to 18 months and involves minimal bureaucratic formalities. At the same time, Bulgarian and Romanian passports grant the same rights as a French passport – residence in France, employment, education, and business activities throughout all EU member states. Accordingly, repatriation to Romania or Bulgaria constitutes the most practical and cost-effective way to obtain the same rights enjoyed by European citizens.

Step-by-Step Procedure for Obtaining French Citizenship

01 Initial Consultation and Case Analysis

02 Preparation of Documents and Dossier Compilation

- birth certificate with apostille and translation;
- French language certificate (B1 level);

- documents confirming residence in France;
- employment contract or proof of occupation;
- birth certificates of children and marriage certificate (if applicable).

We undertake legalization, certified translation, apostille certification, and procurement of all required documents.

03 Online Submission of the Application



Jurpass specialists submit your dossier through the official ANEF portal, pay the state fee, and monitor the review status. FranceConnect credentials are used for access to the system.

04 Monitoring the Procedure and Receiving the Decision



Jurpass lawyers continuously monitor the progress of your case. The standard review period is up to 18 months. Upon approval, a naturalization decree is published.

05 Granting of French Citizenship



Within 6 months following publication of the decree, you receive a certificate of citizenship. Your minor children automatically acquire citizenship provided they reside with you.

06 Issuance of Passport and National Identity Card



Jurpass lawyers arrange issuance of your French passport and national identity card (*carte nationale d'identité*) through the local town hall, handling all formalities on your behalf.

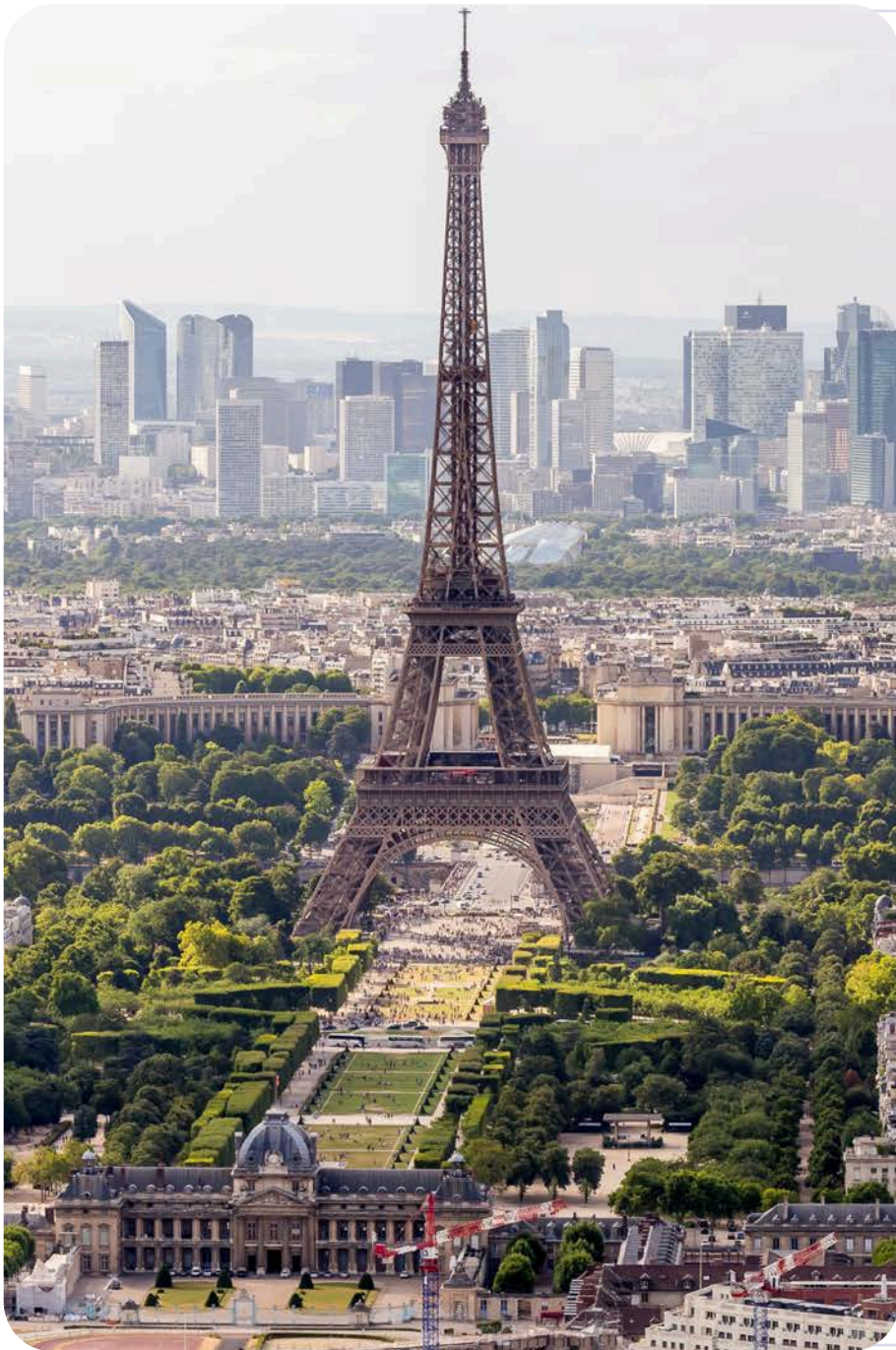
