Holders of Greek passports receive electronic authorization for entry into the United States in nearly 100% of cases, as Greece participates in the U.S. Visa Waiver Program. At the same time, refusal rates for U.S. visas for citizens of most CIS countries remain extremely high.

- Marriage certificate (if surname was changed)
- Proof of Greek origin

- Two color passport-format photographs
- Declaration

## 2. Basic requirements for citizenship applicants

In order to become a citizen of Greece, it is necessary to documentarily confirm your Greek origin. In practice, this means proving the presence of ethnic Greeks in your family line. As confirmation of this fact, parish records, house registers, personal files, and application forms may be used.

As a rule, most applicants do not possess the listed documents and are not aware of their right to citizenship. In such cases, specialists of the company Jurpass come to the assistance, who request the necessary data from archives of Greece and CIS countries. On this basis, a complete dossier is formed proving your right to obtain Greek citizenship.
