Visa on Arrival

[Visa on Arrival](#) is an entry permit issued directly at the point of arrival (airport or seaport) upon payment of a fee.

Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA)

ETA ([Electronic Travel Authorization](#)) — is a simplified electronic permit for visa-free entry obtained online before travel. It is linked to your passport and is required for visiting certain countries with simplified entry regimes.

Obtaining U.S. and Canadian Visas



If long-term residence is required or if ESTA and ETA are not suitable for the intended purpose, Hungarian citizens must apply for visas at U.S. and Canadian consulates. The key advantage is the high level of trust that consulates place in applicants holding Hungarian passports.

According to official statistics, the visa approval rate for Hungarian citizens is approximately 90–95%, while for citizens of the Russian Federation and most CIS countries this figure, according to various sources, does not exceed 50–70%.

This means that Hungarian citizens obtain U.S. and Canadian visas significantly more often and with minimal documentary requirements.

EU Citizenship: Hungary, Romania, or Bulgaria – Choosing the Optimal Path

This makes the Romanian and Bulgarian programs the optimal choice for integration into the European Union.

03 Preparation and Compilation of the Dossier



We prepare your dossier in strict compliance with Hungarian legal requirements. All documents undergo legalization, translation into Hungarian, and notarization.

The final package includes:

- a standard application form;
- a valid international passport;
- a certificate of no criminal record;
- documents confirming Hungarian origin;
- birth and marriage certificates of ancestors;
- birth certificates of children (if applicable);
- a detailed genealogical chart.

04 Submission of Documents to Authorized Authorities



The compiled document package is submitted to the Hungarian consulate at your place of residence or directly to the Department of Citizenship in Budapest. Our lawyers ensure the correctness of submission and the assignment of a registration number for tracking your case.

05 Monitoring the Procedure and Interaction with Government Authorities



After submission of the application, Jurpass specialists continuously monitor the status of your case. In the event of delays or inquiries from authorities, our lawyers promptly submit official requests and take all necessary measures to protect your interests.

06 Obtaining the Citizenship Certificate



Your dossier and application receive approval from the authorized state authority. You receive a certificate confirming the grant of Hungarian citizenship.

07 Issuance of Hungarian Documents



After obtaining Hungarian citizenship status, Jurpass lawyers arrange the issuance of your complete set of Hungarian documents. In particular, you become the holder of a national identity card ([személyi igazolvány](#)) and an international passport.
