Visa on Arrival is an entry permit issued directly at the point of arrival (airport or seaport).

Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA)

ETA ([Electronic Travel Authorization](#)) is a simplified electronic authorization for visa-free entry obtained online before travel. It is linked to your passport and required for visiting certain countries with simplified entry procedures.

Obtaining U.S. and Canadian Visas

For long-term residence in the United States and Canada, Portuguese citizens are required to obtain visas. The key advantage lies in the high level of trust shown by consular authorities. Visas are generally issued within 2–4 weeks on average. For Russian citizens, refusal rates for U.S. and Canadian visas remain relatively high. In 2024, only 65% of applications submitted by Russian citizens were approved.
